

STAINED GLASS WINDOW UPDATE, JULY 2017

The following windows are installed:

St Francis of Assisi, St Ann, Mother of the Blessed Virgin Mary, St Elizabeth Ann Seaton, St. Bernadette Soubirous & Our Lady of Lourdes, St Isidore & St Maria, St Andrew Kim Tae-gon & Paul Chong Ha-sang; The Mystery of the Holy Trinity (West rose window), The Mystery of the Incarnation (North rose window), The Mystery of Grace (east rose window); The Holy Family at Work in Nazareth (narthex entryway); Venerable Fr. Michael McGivney (narthex entryway)

The following windows are under contract for design and fabrication:

THE GREAT WINDOW (South wall of church, featuring main panels in ascending order): **The Marriage Feast at Cana, The Last Supper, & The Wedding Feast of the Lamb**; Side Panel Windows—The Marriage of Joseph & Mary; The Marriage of Adam and Eve; Saint Peter; Saint Paul; The Four Living Creatures at the Throne of God representing the Four Evangelists (Two on Each side top).

Saint Michael, Archangel (South/East clerestory window); **Saint Raphael, Archangel** (South/East clerestory window); **Saint Gabriel, Archangel** (South/East clerestory window); **Our Lady of Pentecost** (narthex); **Saint Pius of Pietrelcina** [aka St. Padre Pio] (narthex entryway); **Saint Albert the Great** (narthex entryway).

These saints, with no indication of priority have also been suggested for consideration: St. Miguel Pro (Mexico, martyr); St. John Vianney (France, Patron of Parish Priests); St Kateri Tekakwitha (1st Native North American St.); St. Martin de Porres (Peru, Spanish/African parentage, Dominican); St Maximillian Kolbe; St Therese of Lisieux (France, Carmelite, Dr of the Church); St Damien de Veuster & St Marianne Cope of Moloka'i, Hawaii; St Anthony of Padua (Portugal, Franciscan, Dr of Church); St Maria Goretti (Italy, Virgin Martyr, Patroness of Teenage Girls); Sts Martha & Mary (with brother Lazarus, Personal Friends of Jesus); St Augustine & St Monica (North Africa, Bp, one of the four great Drs of Church & his mother [patroness of mothers]); St Theresa Benedicta of the Cross (Carmelite, Germany, Virgin Martyr [executed by Nazis] Dr. Edith Stein, co-patroness of Europe); St Mary Magdalene (Disciple of Jesus, 1st to witness Christ Risen); St Frances Xavier Cabrini (Italy, Foundress, American Immigrant, 1st US Citizen saint, Patroness of immigrants); Sts Perpetua & Felicity (Martyrs of North Africa); St Charles Lwanga (Ugandan Martyr); St Patrick & St Brigid of Ireland; St Joan of Arc (France, Virgin Martyr); St Nicholas of Myra (Bp, Patron of Children); St. Martin of Tours (Hungary, France, Bp, Patron of Soldiers); St Ignatius Loyola (Spain, Soldier, Founder of Jesuits [Society of Jesus]); St Thomas Aquinas (Italy, Dominican, Dr of the Church); St Benedict & St Scholastica (Italy, Twins, Founders of the Benedictines); St Agnes (Virgin Martyr); St Luke (Evangelist, Physician, Patron of Medical Profession, Artists); St Dominic de Guzman (Spain, Founder of the Dominicans); St Catherine of Alexandria (Egypt, Virgin, Martyr, Patroness of Philosophers); St Gianna Beretta Molla (Italy, Physician, Surgeon, Wife of Pietro Molla [engineer], Mother [died from complications following the birth of their fourth child]); St Hubert of Liege (Bp, Patron of Hunters); St Claire of Assisi (Virgin, Foundress with St Francis); St Juan Diego Cuauhtlatotzin (Mexico, of the Chichimeca People, received the visits of Our Lady of Guadalupe at Tepeyac); Pope Saint John Paul II; Pope Saint John XXIII; St Junipero Serra; Martyrs of Mexico...
