Diocesan Assessment: Fr. Richard

- Operational bills current but behind with the insurance payment to the Diocese
- Diocesan assessment contributions paid to date \$31, 477.75 with \$63662 due by June 30, 2018.

Capital Campaign: Fr. Richard

- The CCC Capital Campaign Committee is sponsoring speakers for Masses each week. The speakers present after the Homily as that is the time when most parishioners are in attendance.
- The donor tree pamphlet is completed and the tree is up in the lobby of the school.
- The first Sunday of each month will have a second collection for the Legacy of Faith loan.

- The great window will probably take most of 2018 to complete.
- Several windows in the Narthex are close to installation. St. John the Apostle will be installed over the next month.
- Pricing for future windows will increase by 3% starting July 1, 2018 and this was posted in the bulletin. The remaining Narthex windows will increase by \$500.00 and the Clerestory windows will increase by \$400.00 per window.
- Design of clerestory windows continues and Michael, Gabriel and Rafael in process.
