Celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus. The recognized and elect have prepared for months to be received into full communion of the Church on this night. *“Alleluia!”*

Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of Jesus Christ – April 21 – 8:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. and 10:30 p.m. in Spanish; **Jesus Christ is Risen Today. Alleluia! Alleluia!**

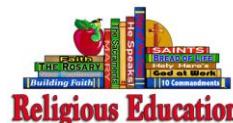
